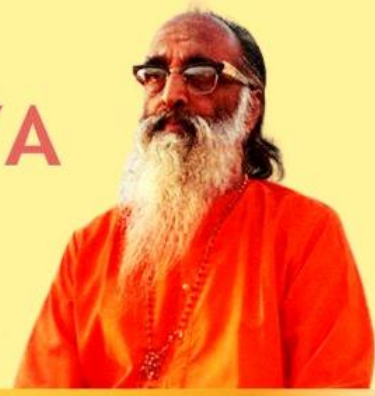

अयं तु महान् खगोलशास्त्रज्ञः आसीत् । तस्य ग्रन्थे मोतीपरीक्षायाः अपि वर्णनं प्राप्यते । आर्यभट्टस्य संशोधनस्य विशेषः प्रभावः अस्मिन् संशोधने दृश्यते । पृथिवी गोलाकारा अस्ति । स्वकीयम् अक्षं परिभ्रमती सा सूर्यं परितः अपि घूर्णाति इति आर्यभट्टस्य सिद्धान्तस्य तेन दृढीकरणं कृतम् । कालगणनायाः कृते पञ्चाङ्गः निर्मितः।

केचन संशोधकाः मन्यन्ते यत् देहल्यां स्थितः कुतुबमिनारः तु वराहमिहिरस्य वेधशाला आसीत् । विक्षणालयस्य वेधशालायाः निर्माणपद्धतयः वराहमिहिरेण अत्यल्पे वित्ते संशोधिताः। एते सर्वे सिद्धान्ताः खगोलशास्त्रीय अध्ययने एव आधारिताः।

प्राचीन-भारतीय-वैज्ञानिकाः न केवलं भारतस्य विज्ञानं प्रदर्शितम् अपितु वेदेभ्यः तथ्यानि स्वीकृत्य सिद्धान्ताः सप्रयोगाः सादरीकृताः। समाजस्य पुरतः विज्ञानस्य परिष्कृतं रूपं प्रस्तूतम् । अतः प्राचीन-भारतीय-वैज्ञानिकानां योगदानम् अवदानं च भारतीय विज्ञानजगति महत्त्वपूर्णमस्ति ।
