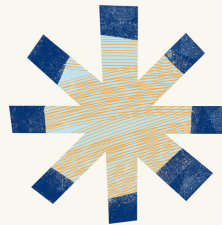

Saying No to Plastic, One Band at a Time

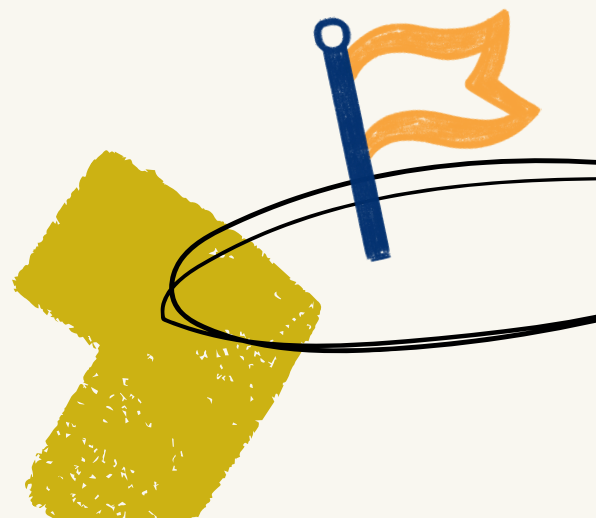

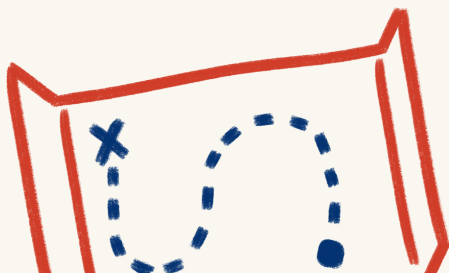

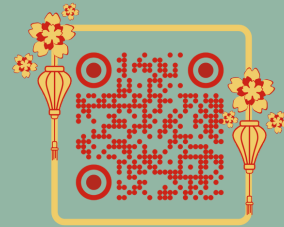
